**Application for New License Check Off Sheet:**

- Include copy of agency’s Certificate of Insurance (COI) listing limits of Professional Liability and Medical Malpractice, Regulation 61.7 §401.A.11
- Include copy of agency’s Board of Pharmacy Permit(s), Regulation 61.7 §401.A.12
- Include copy of agency’s Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendment (CLIA) waiver, Regulation 61.7 §401.A.14
- Include copy of agency’s Infectious Waste Generator Permit(s), Regulation 61.7 §401.A.15
- Include copy of agency’s State and Federal Drug Enforcement(s), if applicable, Regulation 61.7 §401.A.13
- Include a statement on letterhead by Medical Control adopting the SC state protocols and procedures; or a copy of agency’s protocols and procedures within the respective scope of practice for EMT providers. Must be signed and dated, Regulation 61.7 §402.D
- Include an authorized medication list adopted by agency Medical Control Physician(s). Must be signed and dated, Regulation 61.7 §402.
- Include a copy of the Medical Control Physician’s current South Carolina Board of Medical Examiners License, S.C. Code Ann. § 44-61-130 (Supp. 2010)
- Include a copy of agency's respective area(s) business license(s).

Select the method for EMS Electronic Data Submission and follow the corresponding process:

- Continuum™ PCR WebEntry:** Our agency will be utilizing the ePCR WebEntry provided by the State at no cost. The PCR WebEntry does not require configuration or testing. Therefore, you may begin immediately after receiving your agency license. All crewmembers are responsible for completing their ePCR prior to coming off shift, not to exceed twenty-four (24) hours after completion of the incident.
- Software Import:** Our agency will be utilizing commercial software at our cost. The commercial software is NEMESIS V 3.3.4 compliant as listed at [www.nemesis.org](http://www.nemesis.org) . Contact Jeff Robertson at [jrobertson@emspic.org](mailto:jrobertson@emspic.org) to establish configuration and software file testing.
